Our conference dinner is included in full registration – extra tickets can be purchased for \$45.

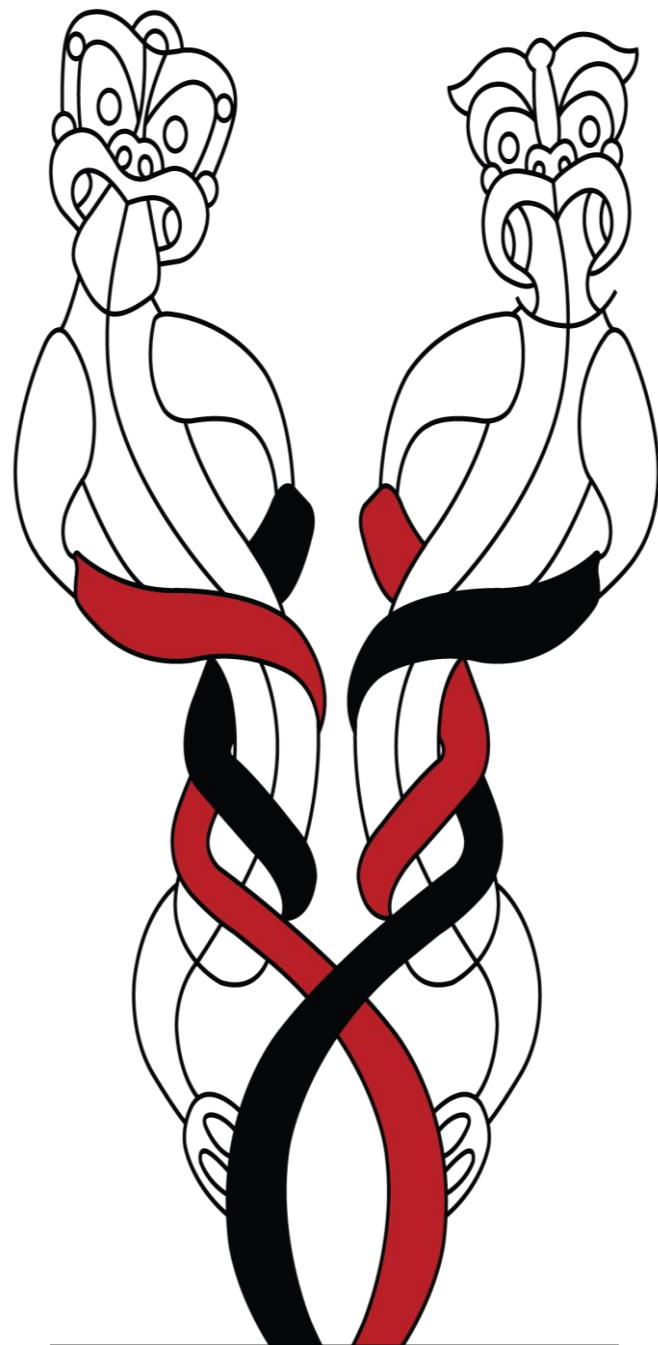
TĀMAKI TOURS

There will also be space in our programme for MAC members to connect during this time, for NZPF delegates and Te Akatea National Executive members to meet.

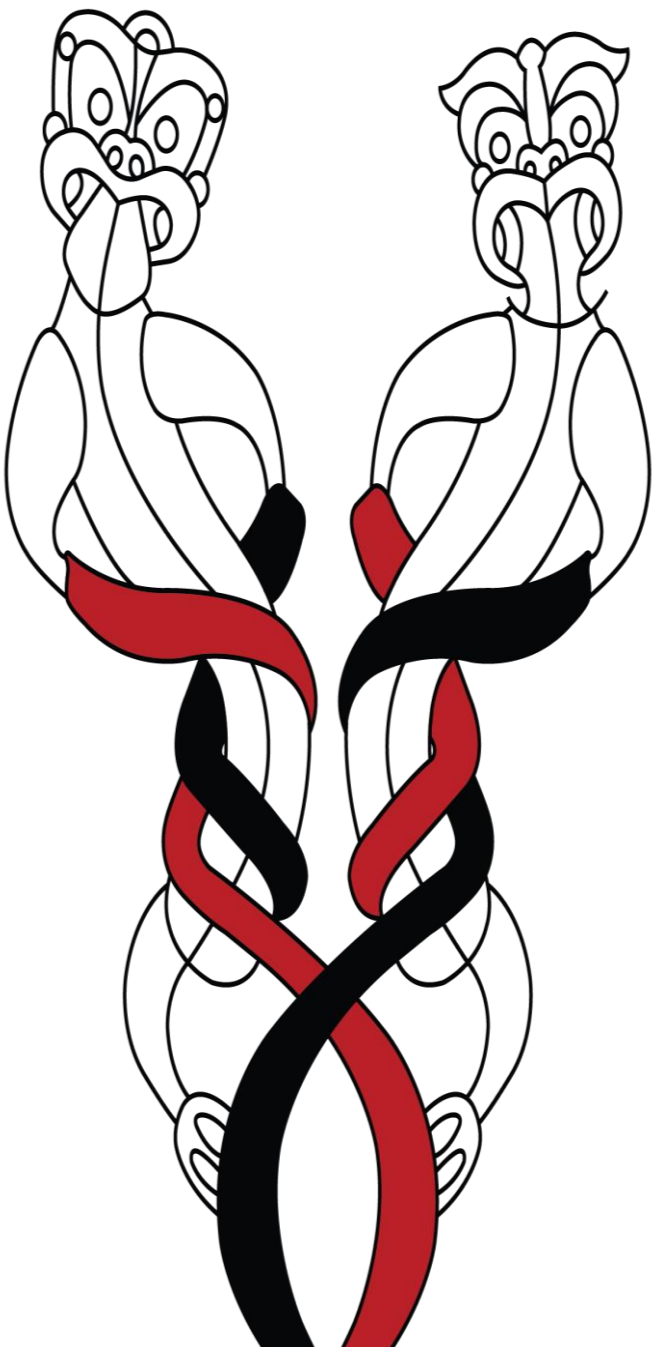
