CONFERENCE MEALS

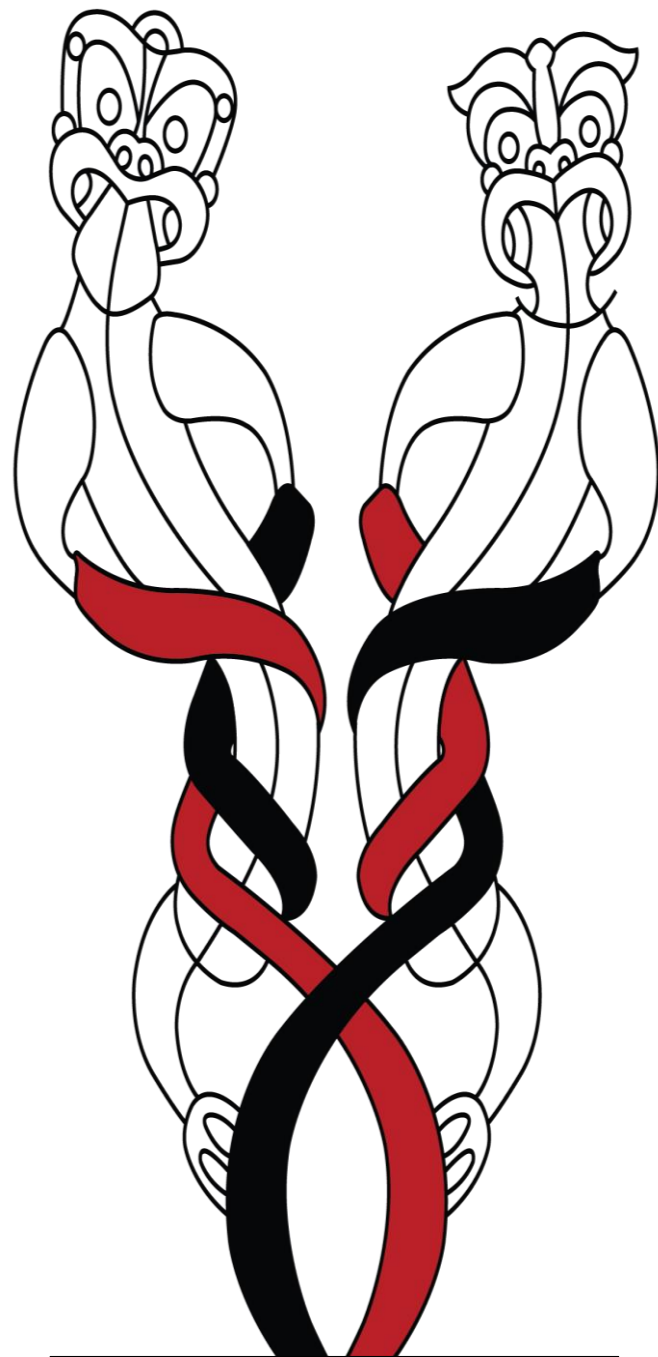

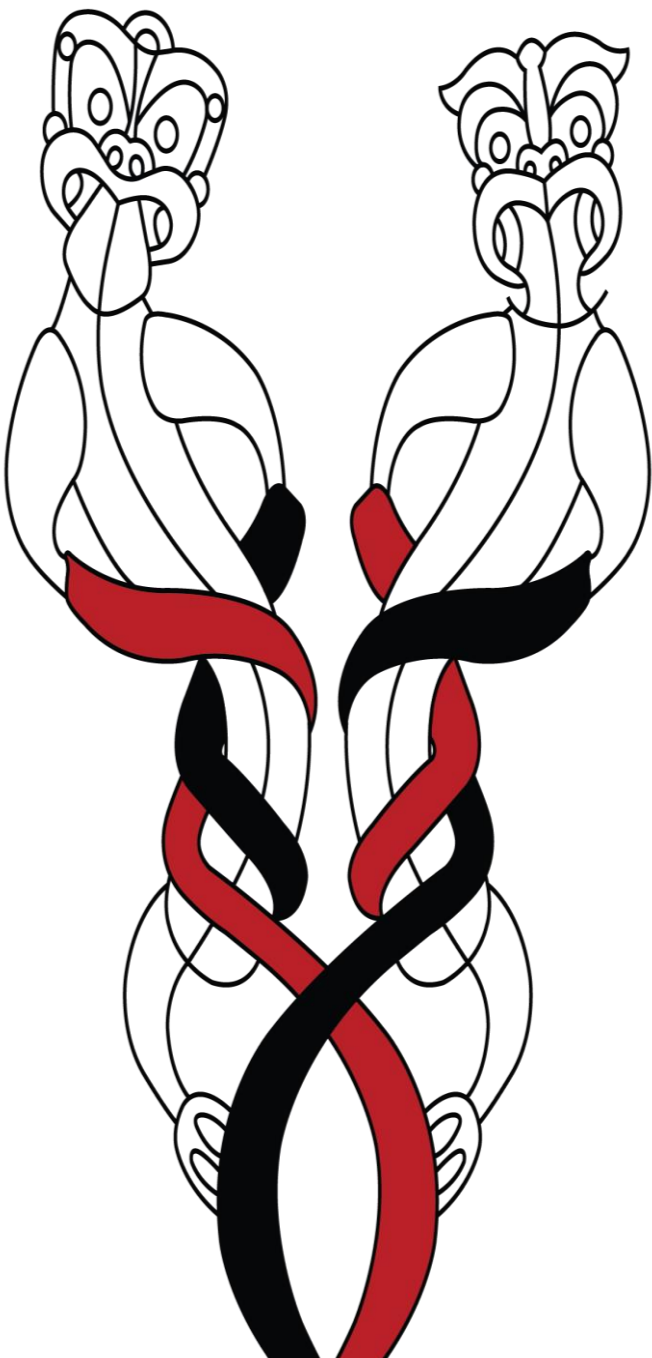
